The US-China 1+2+1 Dual Degree Program is an international education initiative that offers Chinese undergraduate students the opportunity for a truly international education, a degree from both a Chinese and American university and excellent training and language skills. 1+2+1 students spend their freshman year in a Chinese university and their sophomore and junior years at an American university. They return to their home school in China for their senior year. Upon completing all requirements, students receive baccalaureate degrees from each university.
